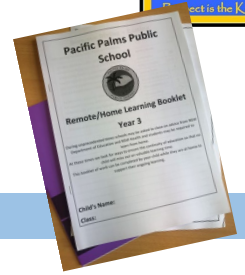


# Pacific Palms Public School

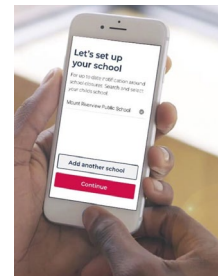
